Earl Spurgeon, 83, Brownstown Rt. 1, died at 1:25 a.m. Saturday, April 29, at the Jackson County Hospital.

A lifelong resident of Jackson County, he was a retired farmer and attended the Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church near Brownstown.

He was born Jan. 11, 1895, in Freetown, to the late John "Wes" Wesley and Laura Alice White Spurgeon. On May 22, 1914, he was married in Freetown to the former Nellie Wheeler, who survives.
