## Mrs. Lillie L. Spurgeon Expires at Brownstown

Mrs. Lillie L. Spurgeon, age seventy-one, a life-long resident of Brownstown, died early today at her home in Brownstown, following a critical illness of five weeks' duration. Mrs. Spurgeon had been in failing health for about six months.

Born on November 5, 1872, the daughter of Jefferson and Mary Corthun Weathers, Mrs. Spurgeon was well-known throughout Brownstown and was an active member of the Brownstown Christian Church until her health began to fail. She leaves a wide circle of friends who join with relatives in mourning her death.

Mrs. Spurgeon's husband, James J. Spurgeon, whom she married September 13, 1894, preceded her in death several years ago.

Survivors include seven children, Clarence Spurgeon, of Brownstown; James W. Spurgeon, who is serving with the armed forces at Fort Benjamin Harrison; Mrs. Gladys Findley, of this city; Mrs. Ruth Reinbold, of Brownstown; Mrs. Lorena Miller, of Connersville; Mrs. Margaret DeLong, of Brownstown; and Mrs. Maxine Carr, of Brownstown.

Four sisters, Mrs. Maggie Lebo, of Fort Meade, Fla.; Mrs. Alcie Reddick, of Columbus; and Mrs. Lizzie Sharon and Mrs. Edna Harmon, both of this city, also survive, as do four grandchildren.

Funeral services are to be conducted at 2:30 o'clock Saturday afternoon from the Spurgeon home, with the Rev. John U. Phelps, pastor of the Christian Church at Brownstown, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery at Brownstown.
