Raymond Spurgeon, Post Office Head, Dies

BROWNSTOWN — Raymond P. Spurgeon, 54, of 302 S. Jackson, Brownstown postmaster, died at 3:04 a.m. today at Jackson County Hospital at Seymour after a 10-week illness.

He had been postmaster for 19 years.

Funeral service will be conducted by the Rev. Howard Pauley and the Rev. Neal McCoy at 1:30 p.m. Monday at Winklepleck-Weesner Funeral Home here, where persons may call after 11 a.m. Sunday. Burial will be at Fairview Cemetery at Brownstown.

Spurgeon was born in Jackson County Aug. 24, 1927, the son of Bee and Hazel Taylor Spurgeon of Route 1. On Sept. 26, 1954, he married Dorothy McElfresh, who survives.

an of World War II, was a member and elder of Honeytown Christian Church and a member of the National Association of Retired Federal Employees. He had been a member of both Brownstown American Legion and Brownstown Knights of Pythias for 35 years.

In addition to his postmaster duties, Spurgeon also farmed.
