Mrs. Georgia Stafford Dies After Brief Illness, Rites Tuesday ,

Brownstown residents were shocked and grieved Saturday to learn of the death of Mrs. Georgia Stafford, Medora R1.

Ill only a few days, Mrs. Stafford died at 8:00 o'clock that morning in Robert Long Hospital, Indianapolis.
