James Howard Stall, 58, Indianapolis, died Sunday, March 13, at the Halifax Medical Center, Daytona Beach, Fla.

An Army veteran of the Korean War, he served as district director for Farmers Home Administration for 20 years. Mr. Stall was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church and Indianapolis American Legion Post 500.
