Robert Stang Dies Suddenly

Robert G. Stang, 61, of Indianapolis, husband of the former Kathleen Cummings, of Brownstown, suffered a fatal heart attack in downtown Indianapolis Monday afternoon.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10 a. m. Thursday from St. Luke's Roman Catholic Church in Indianapolis with burial in a cemetery at Brownstown.
