

Harold Stepp, 70, services Tuesday

Harold Stepp, 70, of Medora R1 died at 2:50 p.m. Saturday at Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital in Seymour after being ill for a year.

Mr. Stepp was a member of the Baptist Church in Columbus and a U.S. Army veteran of World War II. He retired from Arvin Industries in Columbus after working there for 44 years.

Mr. Stepp was born in Bartholomew County to Carl Stepp and Edith Webb on May 18, 1917.

Mr. Stepp was married to Georgia McCollum on March 18, 1941. She died on Feb. 11, 1977. He was later married to Mary M. Cockerham on Nov. 11, 1977. She survives.
