

John W. H. Stevens Dies at Brownstown

John W. H. Stevens, age seventy-one, a life-long resident of Jackson county, died late Wednesday night at his home in Brownstown. He had been ill for the past several years.

Mr. Stevens was born on March 2, 1874. in Jackson county, the son of David and Sarah Jane Marott Stevens, both deceased. He was married on April 1, 1899, in Brownstown to Martha Smith, who died on July 6, 1918.
