MRS. SARAH STEVENS IS CALLED BY DEATH

**Aged County Woman Dies at
Home of Daughter, Mrs.
Guy Beatty.**

Mrs. Sarah Jane Stevens, age eighty-nine, a life-long resident of Jackson and Brown counties, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Guy Beatty, 203 South Chestnut street, at 8 o'clock Sunday night. Death followed an illness of ten days' duration with a complication of diseases.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Tuesday afternoon from the Brownstown Christian Church with the Rev. E. E. Pedicord, of Brownstown, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Friends may call at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Beatty, 203 South Chestnut street, after 7 o'clock tonight.

Mrs. Stevens was born on April 28, 1851, in Nashville, Ind., the daughter of George and Mary

Buskin Marlett, both deceased. She was married in October, 1872, at Nashville, Ind., to David Stevens, who died on August 4, 1906. She was a member of the Christian Church in Brown county and was the widow of a Civil War veteran. A host of friends mourn her passing.

Five children preceded her in death. She is survived by five children: John Stevens, of Brownstown; Riley Stevens, of Brownstown; Mrs. Virgil Miller, of Brownstown; Arthur L. Stevens, of Marion, Ind., and Mrs. Martha Beatty, of this city. A brother, James Marlett, residing on a Columbus rural route; eighteen grandchildren, twenty-seven great grandchildren and one great, great grandchild also survives.
