Forrest R. "Fields" Stewart, 74, of 804 W. Walnut St., Brownstown, died at 7:15 p.m. Sunday, June 13, at the Bartholomew County Hospital in Columbus, following an illness of three months.

For many years Mr. Stewart, who had resided in this county most of his life, was associated with his late brother, Wilbur Stewart, in the operation of the former Stewart Electric Company, in Brownstown. In recent months he had been employed with Lockman TV, Brownstown.

Born in Tipton Feb. 6, 1902, the son of the late Arthur and Ada Jones Stewart, Mr. Stewart was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church, of which he was serving as a deacon at the time of his death.

He was married Sept. 4, 1927, in Seymour, to Leona B. Snider, who survives.

Other survivors include one son, George F. Stewart, who recently moved with his wife, the former Miss Jackie Stiles, to Grandview Lake, Columbus, after being stationed for several years in Hawaii with the Secret Service, and one daughter, Mrs. Marvin (Janet) Has, of Lexington, Ky. Seven grandchildren also survive.

Funeral services were scheduled at 2 p.m. today, Wednesday, June 16, from the Winklepleck-Weesner Funeral Home in Brownstown with the Rev. Elvin Gray, of the Brownstown Christian Church, officiating. Burial will be in Fairview Cemetery.
