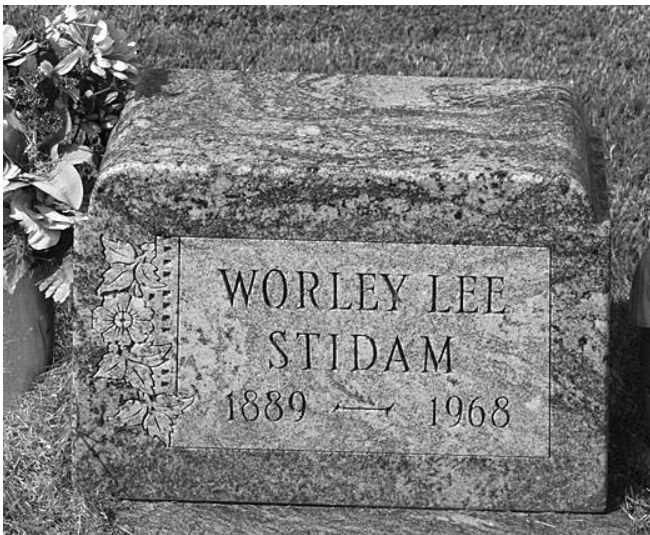

W. L. Stidam, 78, B'town R2, Dies Saturday

A retired farmer and a member of the Southern Baptist Church in Virginia, Mr. Stidam died at 2:50 p. m. Saturday at Schneck Memorial Hospital here. He had been seriously ill for two weeks.
