Stotz—Following a long illness of dropsy and heart trouble, Mrs. John Stotz passed away at her home in Brownstown Thursday afternoon, June 28, 1928, aged 70 years, 9 months and 22 days.

Funeral services were conducted at the Presbyterian church, of which she was a member, Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. Roy Brumbaugh officiating, followed by burial in Fairview cemetery.
