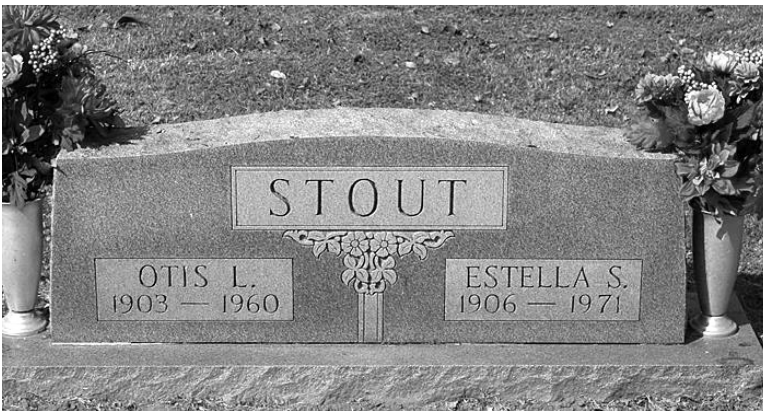

## Otis Lee Stout Dies Today—Services Set

Otis Lee Stout, 56, Freetown R1, died about 5:30 a. m. today at his residence, west of Brownstown, after being in failing health for about six weeks.

Mr. Stout, an employe for several years at the Brownstown Feed Exchange, was a life-long resident of Jackson County.
