## Mrs. Mary E. Strange Dies Very Suddenly

Funeral rites were held Monday afternoon from the Zabel Funeral Home for Mrs. Mary E. Strange, who died very suddenly at 1:30 o'clock last Saturday afternoon at the family home, 503 South Main street.

Mrs. Strange had been in failing health for the past two years.

Evan Bolejack, pastor of the Brownstown Christian Church, of which the deceased was a member, was in charge of the memorial rites and burial was in Fairview Cemetery.

Born in Mitchell, December 22, 1912, Mrs. Strange was a daughter of the late Levi and Minnie McBroom Pavey. She was married in Bedford, March 25, 1928, to John W. Strange, who survives.

Mr. Strange only recently was a patient at the Veteran's Administration Hospital in Louisville, Kentucky.
