Arthur D. Strouse, 79, of Old Vallonia Road, Brownstown, died at 9:46 a.m. Tuesday at Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital following a two-year illness.

A World War II veteran of the U.S. Army, he had been a farmer. A member of Brownstown Christian Church, Masonic Lodge in Brownstown and the Eastern Star, he retired in 1979 from Morgan's Packing Co., Austin.

Born Oct. 15, 1913, in Scottsburg, he was a son of Worth Herman and Lula Thomas Strouse. He married Marjorie Pillman on May 17, 1947, in Uniontown, and she survives.
