Eugene Summa, Indianapolis, Dies Here

Eugene G. Summa, 59, of Indianapolis, was dead on arrival at Schneck Memorial Hospital at 8:37 p. m. Sunday, after suffering an apparent heart attack. He became ill while visiting in Brownstown at the home of his wife's sisters, Miss Esther and Miss Mary Hotchkiss, West Walnut street.

A resident of Indianapolis for 49 years, he was a federal employe of the Indianapolis Post Office for 36 years and a member of Craft Union No. 78 and of Capitol City Lodge No. 312, Free and Accepted Masons.

He was also a member of the Brownstown Christian Church.

Born April 6, 1911, in Jackson County, he was the son of the late George W. and Carrie Leudtke Summa.

On May 28, 1954 in Indianapolis he married the former Virginia Hotchkiss.
