Virginia H. Summa, 101, Brownstown, passed away at 10:50 p.m. Tuesday, March 11, 2014, at Hoosier Christian Village, Brownstown.

Virginia was a member of Brownstown Christian Church. She served in the U.S. Army during World War II and the Korean War. She was a clerk and stenographer with the U.S. Department of Agriculture. She was a member of Eastern Star Lodge 264, Brownstown.

Born Sept. 5, 1912, in Vallonia, she was the daughter of S.M. and Myrtle Lockman Hotchkiss Sr., both of whom preceded her in death. In May 1954, she married Eugene G.
