## Norval Sweeney

Feb. 7, 1940 – Jan. 13, 2008

Norval "Bud" Sweeney, 67, Brownstown, died at 3:30 p.m. Sunday, Jan. 13, 2008, at Schneck Medical Center, Seymour.
