George Taskey, 87, Brownstown, died at 5:32 p.m. Saturday, May 30, at Hoosier Christian Village in Brownstown after an illness of 1½ years.

Funeral services were conducted at 1 p.m. Tuesday, June 2, at Johnson Funeral Home in Vallonia where Rev. Doug Nuss and William Chowning presided.

Burial was in Fairview Cemetery at Brownstown.

Born Aug. 7, 1894, in Cortland, Taskey was a son of the late William and Sophia Mackey Taskey.

He married the former Della Hall on May 8, 1920, in Brownstown, and she died in June 1947.
