Paul John Terkhorn, 65, 115 S. Frances St., Brownstown, died unexpectedly at 12:42 a.m. Saturday, Dec. 12, at the Jackson County Hospital emergency room.

An Army veteran of World War II, he retired after working for the Jackson County REMC. He was a lifetime member of the Disabled American Veterans and a member of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church and Brownstown American Legion Post 112.

A lifelong resident of Jackson County, he was born Jan. 21, 1922, in Jackson County to the late Henry K. and Louise Wolka Terkhorn. On Sept. 18, 1947, he married Mariana Gabbert in Brownstown, and she survives.
