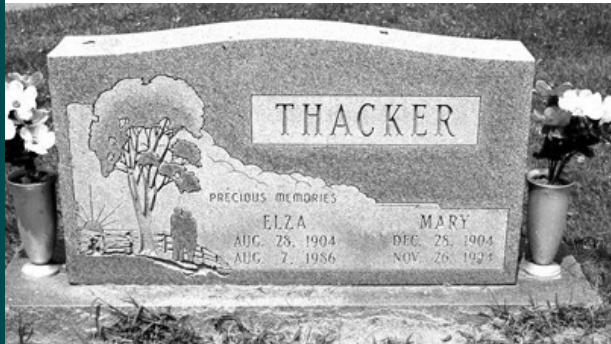

Elza Thacker, 81, of 216 E. Cross St., Brownstown, died at 6:50 a.m. today at Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital. He had been ill for several years.
