

Mrs. M. Applewhite, **Of Brownstown**, **Dies**

Mrs. Myrtle Bolles Apple-white, 92, Brownstown businesswoman and well-known civic leader, died at 3 p. m. Sunday at her home, 1026 West Spring street, Brownstown. A lifelong resident of Browns-

town, she was born December 17, 1875 to W. R. and Rachel Robertson Bolles. On June 5, 1900, she was married at Brownstown to Ralph B. Apple-white, who preceded her in death on February 10, 1920.

Mrs. Applewhite was a mem-ber of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church. She was secre-tary of the Brownstown Public Library for 50 years and served as treasurer of Fairview Ceme-tery in Brownstown for 50 years.
