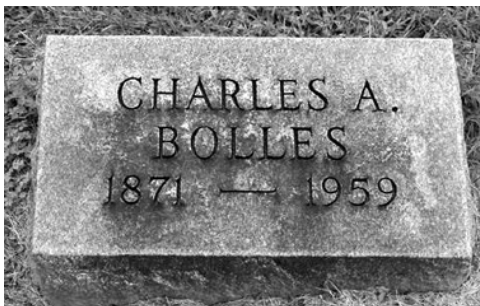

## C. A. Bolles, Former Local Resident, Dies Tuesday

After an illness of several years, Charles A. Bolles died in his sleep Tuesday evening about six o'clock in an Indianapolis sanitarium, where he had been a patient. Mr. Bolles is a former Brownstown resident and was the brother of Mrs. Ralph B. Applewhite, of Brownstown.

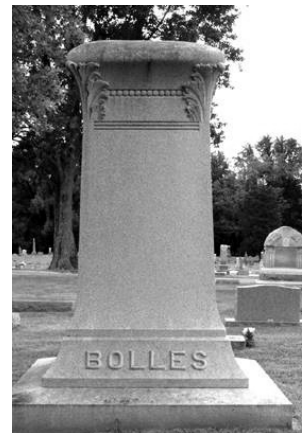
Born in Brownstown August 27, 1871, he was the son of William Riley and Rachel Robertson Bolles. He was married in January, 1900, to Miss Mabel Scott, who died just two years ago, December 8, 1957.

Survivors include one son, Richard Bolles, of Port Arthur, Texas, eleven grandchildren, four great-grandchildren, and one sister, Mrs. Applewhite.

Mr. Bolles lived in Brownstown until 1940 when he and the late Mrs. Bolles moved to Indianapolis to care for her mother, who was ill.

He was a member of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church until after he moved to Indianapolis, when both he and Mrs. Bolles moved their membership to the North Central Methodist Church. He had been a member of Washington Lodge No. 13, F. & A. M. for sixty-two years and also was a member of Jackson Lodge 146, F. & A. M.

Possessing a kindly disposition,



he was loved by his many friends and was respected for his high moral standards and integrity.

Graveside rites will be held at Fairview Cemetery here at 11:00 o'clock Friday morning, following funeral services in Indianapolis. The Rev. Edsel Granger, pastor of the Brownstown Presbyterian church, will officiate.
