Robertson—Mrs. Bernice Robertson, wife of Van Robertson, passed away at her home on Spring street Monday evening at 4:30 o'clock after a lingering illness of hardening of the liver, aged 44 years, 2 months and 5 days.

She was the eldest daughter of Chas. and Isabelle Robertson, both deceased, and was born in Brownstown August 25, 1878. She was united in marriage to Van Robertson February 2, 1902. To their union were born two daughters, Ersel and Mona Lois, who with their father, survives her. She also leaves one sister, Mrs. Mona Shields, of Brownstown, and four brothers, C. O. Robertson and Roscoe Robertson, of Brownstown; Dunham Robertson of Martinsville and Edmond Robertson of Newport, Ky.

In early childhood she united with the Christian church. Before her health failed she was identified with the active work thereof, giving ever generously of her time, strength and means to the various interests of the church. She was also a member of the Wednesday Club and Pythian Sisters. She was a woman of many excellent traits of character, a kind neighbor and a devoted wife and mother.

Funeral services, conducted by Rev. C. H. Earenfight, pastor of the Christian church, was held at the family home this afternoon at 2 o'clock. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
