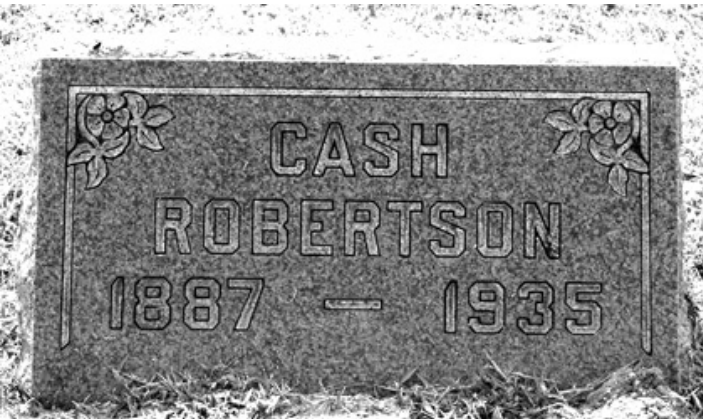

**Cash Robertson
Passes Away At
1:30 P.M. Today**

**Well Known Brownstown Town-
ship Farmer Expires Following
'Three Months' Illness.**

Cash Robertson is dead!

Those few words cast a gloom of sorrow when it was learned that he had passed away at his home about a half mile west of Brownstown this afternoon at one-thirty o'clock.

He was taken sick the first of January and had been in ill health since that time. However, he got better and was able to be up and about the house, but was taken worse Tuesday night. The immediate cause of his death was septicaemia.

Deceased was the son of L. R. and Kate Cash Robertson. He was born at Newman, Illinois, April 19, 1887. He came to Jackson county with his parents in 1888, where he resided until his death. He was a farmer by occupation and was well known.

On January 22, 1913, he was married at Bartlettsville, Ohio, to Miss Gladys Crewson, who survives.

Besides the widow he leaves two daughters Mildred and Janet, both at home. He also leaves his aged father and step-mother, and four brothers, Fred, of Seymour; Ward, of North Vernon; Harry of Kansas City, Mo., and Paul, of North Vernon.

Funeral arrangements had not been made as we go to press.
