## Van 'Blackie' Robertson, 87, B'town, Ex-Local Sheriff, Businessman, Dies

Van "Blackie" Robertson, 87, Mary VanCleave Robertson, died at 5:30 p. m. Wednesday at his Brownstown residence. He was married June 29, 1930, in Kentucky to Inez Pierrer, had been ill for about a year. who survives.

A retired Jackson County businessman, Mr. Robertson was the last surviving charter member of Seymour Aerie No. 685, Fraternal Order of Eagles. He also was a member of the Seymour Lodge No. 462, Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks.

He served for eight years as deputy sheriff and was elected sheriff of Jackson County, serving two terms from 1912 to 1916.

He was a member of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church.
