

Donald T. Thompson, 20, Dies In Bedford Hospital Early Sunday Morning From In-juries Suffered In Two-Car

Funeral rites were held this afternoon from the Zabel Funeral Home for Donald T. Thompson, 20, son of Mr. and Mrs. Tal-madge Thompson, of Browns-

Young Thompson died in the Dunn Memorial Hospital, Bed-ford, at 1:30 o'clock Sunday mrning, one and one-half hours suffering head, chest and internal injuries, when the car he was driving figured in a two-car accident on U.S. Highway 50, 1.4 miles south of Bedford.

The accident is still under invectigation by State Trooper Jim Sutton. of the Bloomington subpost, the Lawrence county deputy sheriff and Lawrence coroner

In all probability charges will be filed against Tincher, according to informed sources.
