## Raymond Thompson rites Friday

Raymond M. Thompson, 54, of Brownstown R2 died at 3:30 a.m. Tuesday at his home.

Founder of The Master's Touch Christian Children's Home, Brownstown, which was in operation in 1977-87, he had been employed by the Brownstown Central Community Schools.

A member and former elder of Brownstown Christian Church, he lived all his life in Jackson County. He had also been an elder at Surprise Christian Church.

Born Oct. 19, 1938, in Bloomington, he was a son of Foy and Mabel Thompson. He married Beverly Johnson on April 28, 1957, in Brownstown, and she survives.
