## THOMAS G. THOMPSON IS CALLED BY DEATH

Native of Jackson County Passes Away at Home of Nephew in This City.

Thomas G. Thompson, a native of Jackson county, age sixty-nine, died at the home of his nephew, J. Robert Blair, 217 North Lynn street, at 6:30 o'clock Wednesday night.

Mr. Thompson, a night clerk at the LaSalle Hotel, Indianapolis, became ill Christmas night, and was brought here Tuesday from Indianapolis. He had been in ill health for a number of years. He was well known not only in this county, but in Indianapolis and other localities. He had spent about thirty years of his life in Indianapolis, and spent some time in Gibson, a suburb of Hammond, Ind., where he was assistant manager of the Railroad T. M. C. A.

He was a member of the Salem K. of P. lodge, and of the First Baptist Church, of this city.

In 1890 he was married to Minnie Sturgeon, in Jackson county. She died in 1899. Two sons are also deceased.
