## Mrs. Myrtle Tinch Dies —Services Wednesday

Mrs. Myrtle Tinch, 83, of Brownstown, widow of Charles C. Tinch, died at 8:45 p. m. Sunday at the Roselawn Nursing Home, Seymour. In failing health for one year, Mrs. Tinch had been a resident of the nursing home for just one week prior to her death.

A native and life-long resident of Jackson County, she was born December 3, 1877 at Freetown, daughter of the late Levi and Lucy Harper Spurgeon.
