Alvin Toppe Dies, Rites Set Wednesday

Alvin Toppe, 75, of 121 East Commerce street, Brownstown, died Monday morning at the Jackson Park Convalescent Center in Seymour. He had been in failing health for some time.

He was a Jackson County native and a retired farmer.

Born May 17, 1902 in Jackson County, he was the son of the late William and Lizzie Altemeyer Toppe.

On Feb. 5, 1926, he was married in Brownstown to the former Addie Emma Fogelding, who survives.
