William C. Toppe, 66, Dies Suddenly Monday

William C. Toppe, 66, of 209 Calvin Boulevard, died suddenly at 11 p. m. Monday in Schneck Memorial Hospital. He was admitted to the hospital Sunday for medical treatment.

A native and life-long resident of Jackson County, he was born November 4, 1894, son of the late Henry and Mary Stille Toppe.

On November 8, 1930, Mr. Toppe married the former Mabel Wilson at Brownstown. The widow survives.

Mr. Toppe was a janitor at Broad Ripple High School in Indianapolis for the past 15 years, commuting to his job each day. He was a veteran of World War I, a member of Seymour American Legion Post No. 89 and the Modern Woodmen of America.

Surviving, in addition to the widow, are a brother, Henry Toppe, Pendleton, and a sister, Mrs. Mary Griffith, Indianapolis.

Mr. Toppe was preceded in death by a brother, Fred Toppe.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p. m. Thursday from the Voss Chapel with the Rev. Harold Barnett, of Austin, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
