## ***Death Summons Mrs. Trueblood***

**Resident of Acme Vicinity Dies at  
Father's Home at Pleasant  
Grove.**

Mrs. Anna Fern Trueblood, age thirty-one, a resident of Acme where her husband operates a service station, died at 11:30 o'clock Wednesday night at the home of her father, George B. Lucas, in the Pleasant Grove neighborhood. Death followed an illness of about two weeks.

Mrs. Trueblood was born on September 2, 1904, the daughter of George B. and Sina Lucas, both of whom survive. She was married in 1927 to Price Trueblood, who survives. She was a member of the Pleasant Grove Church and during her residence in the Pleasant Grove and Acme vicinities made a host of friends who mourn her passing.
