Mrs. Polly Tucker Dead.

Mrs. Polly Tucker, one of the oldest residents of Brownstown, died at 6:15 o'clock this morning at her home. She was born in Brownstown March 22, 1836, and would have been 77 years old next month. For seven years she has suffered from paralysis and three years ago she fell and fractured her hip. Since that time she has been unable to walk. When a young woman, she was married to William Tucker, who enlisted in the Union army during the war, and died in 1863. He was taken sick while in service and died on his way home. Mrs. Tucker has two children, Mrs. John Tovey and Leander Tucker, both of whom live in Brownstown. She also leaves two sisters and one brother, John Bland, of Oaklahoma; Mrs. Hettie Burrell, of Brownstown; and Mrs. Phillip Reinbolt, of Indianapolis. Mrs. Tucker has been a member of the M. E. church at Brownstown since she was thirteen years old, and the funeral will be conducted from that church Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock by the pastor, Rev. E. F. Schneider.
