Wm. A. Utterback Called By Death

William A. Utterback, age seventy-two, prominent county resident who formerly operated a hotel at Ewing and also a hotel at Chesterfield, Ind., died at 12:30 o'clock Tuesday afternoon at his home in Clearspring.

Mr. Utterback had been in failing health for about a year but his death, due to heart disease, occurred after only an hour's illness.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10 o'clock Thursday morning from the Wallace Funeral Home in Brownstown. Burial in Fairview Cemetery.

Mr. Utterback, who operated a hotel in Chesterfield for nine years, was born on February 9, 1867, the son of Henry and Abigail Terrell Utterback. He was married on April 19, 1898, at Bedford, to Luella Fields, who survives. He operated a hotel in Ewing for a number of years and became well known throughout the county. He was liberal in his contributions to religious and civic causes and made many friends throughout the county who mourn his death.

Besides the widow, he is survived by a step-daughter, Mrs. Rollie Louden, of this city; a sister, Mrs. Emma Keithley, of Norman; an uncle, Ed Utterback, of this city; seven step-grandchildren and two step-grandchildren.
