VEHSLAGE-Henry C. Vehslage, Jr., was born May 19, 1857, and died at the home of his father, Henry Vehslage, near Vallonia, Tuesday afternoon, January 31, 1911, of heart trouble, aged 59 years, 8 months and 12 days. He had not been feeling well for several days, but on the day of his death did not seem any worse than usual. He ate a hearty dinner at the noon hour and in the afternoon I. W. Burcham, a neighbor, was at the Vehslage home and he and Henry were talking and joking. When Mr. Burcham started home he had only reached the yard when members of the family called to him to come back that Henry was very sick, after reaching the house he only lived a short time. Thus has death but with a brief warning, called one whose kind disposition endeared him to all.

Deceased was the eldest son of Henry Vehslage and was born and raised on the farm where he died. He was of a quiet disposition and was loved and respected by all who knew him. Besides his aged father he leaves three sisters, viz: Mrs. Lizzie Stunkel, of Seymour; Mrs. Anna Peters, of Vallonia, and Miss Dora, who lived at home, and who have the sympathy of
