OBITUARY.

DIED.—Louisa Vehslage, at her home near Vallonia, Ind., Saturday, July 7, 1906, at 2 o'clock P. M. aged 81 years, 10 months, and 9 days. Funeral services were conducted Monday July 9, 1906, at 10 o'clock A. M. at the family residence and at 10:45 A. M. at the Presbyterian church in Brownstown Rev. J. H. Weaver officiating, after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.

Mrs Vehslage (whose maiden name was Louisa D. C Fopay) was born in Prussia, Altendorf, August 28, 1824, and came to America with her parents in 1842. She was united in marriage to Henry Vehslage in Louisville September 17, 1848. They came to Jackson county in 1850 locating near Sauers. In 1852 they moved on a farm near Vallonia where they have since lived. They were the parents of nine children—five sons and four daughters. Those surviving her are her aged husband, one son and daughter at home—Henry and Dora; Mrs. Fred Stunkel, of Seymour, and Mrs. Wm. Peters, of Driftwood township; also one brother—Fred Fopay, of Deitrich, Ills., and one sister, Mrs. Louis Masher, of Wheeler, Ill., and fifteen grand-children. Mrs. Vehslage was a kind wife, mother and neighbor and will be missed by many. The family have the sympathy of the entire community.
