MRS. FLORA A. VINSON, wife of J. L. Vinson, night operator at this place, died Saturday, August 24, 1901, of lung trouble, aged 43 years, 5 months and 13 days. She had been in failing health for some months past but her family did not realize the seriousness of her condition until a few days prior to her death. The funeral services were held at the M. E. church Monday afternoon, after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.

Flora Hamilton was born at Aurora, March 11, 1859, and was united in marriage at Dillsboro, to J. L. Vinson, March 2, 1879. To their union were born five children, one girl dying in infancy, and three daughters and one son, who with their father, are still living. She came with her husband to this county in 1887. They lived at Medora a few years and then moved to Vallonia where they resided until March, 1900, when they came to Brownstown, where they have since resided. Her mother, one brother and one sister also survive her.

Mrs. Vinson was truly a christian woman in every sense of the word and was an untiring worker in the cause of Christ. She united with the M. E. church at Dillsboro in 1877, since which time she has been prominently connected with various department of church work. She was a devoted and loving mother and wife. She leaves the world better by her having lived in it. The relatives have the sympathy of many friends in their bereavement.
