Deputy Sheriff's Brother Is Dead

George H. W. VonDielingen, age forty-five, brother of Deputy Sheriff William VonDielingen, died at his home on Road 250 near Brownstown Saturday afternoon at 4 o'clock. He had been ill about three weeks.
