Theodore Wagoner, 63, Medora, died at 2 p.m. Saturday, Aug. 1, at the Hospitality House nursing home in Bedford. He had been ill eight months.

He was a retired railroad employee and a member of the Brownstown Baptist Church. He was a veteran of the Second World War.

Born May 15, 1918, in Brownstown, he was the son of the late James and Josephine Henderson Wagoner. He lived in Brownstown until 1975, when he moved to Medora.
