Mr. James Leroy Warren, 74, of Brownstown, Indiana, passed away at 8:35 a.m. Tuesday, March 6, 2012, at Schneck Medical Center, Seymour.

Mr. Warren was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church where he served as a trustee. He was employed by Mitchell and Stark Construction Company, starting in 1955 and retiring from full time employment in 1995. He was co-owner of Bane and Warren Construction and Hillview Trailer Court which he co-founded in 1964. He was President of the Brownstown Town Council for 16 years and was very active in all civic affairs. He was named Citizen of the Year by the Brownstown Chamber of Commerce in 1997-1998 and was awarded the Book of Golden Deeds by the Brownstown Exchange Club in 2011. He was honored by the Jackson County Industrial Development Corp. in 2011 for his support of industrial and economic development in Brownstown. He was selected as grand marshal of the Brownstown Melonfest parade in 2008. He was a supporter of Brownstown Central Athletics and was inducted into the school's Athletic Hall of Fame in October 2011. He served as a member of the football chain crew for 25 years and had been a season ticket holder at Brownstown Central High School since 1964. He enjoyed watching his grandchildren in all sports and attended most of their events. He was a fan of Indiana University basketball and football and was a season ticket holder for more than 20 years. He was an unselfish person when it came to the town of Brownstown, both financially and in donating his time. With his wife Sara at his side, his projects of beautification will be appreciated for many years to come. He was a member of the Indiana Laborers Union, The Elks Lodge 462 in Seymour, and Washington Lodge 13 Free and Accepted Masons of Brownstown where he received his 50-year pin.

Born August 15, 1937, in Jackson County, he was the son of Walter and Elizabeth Hansome Warren, both of whom preceded in death. On May 31, 1957, in the Norman Christian Church, he married Sara Jean Bowman, who survives.

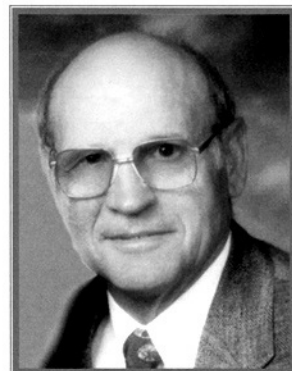
