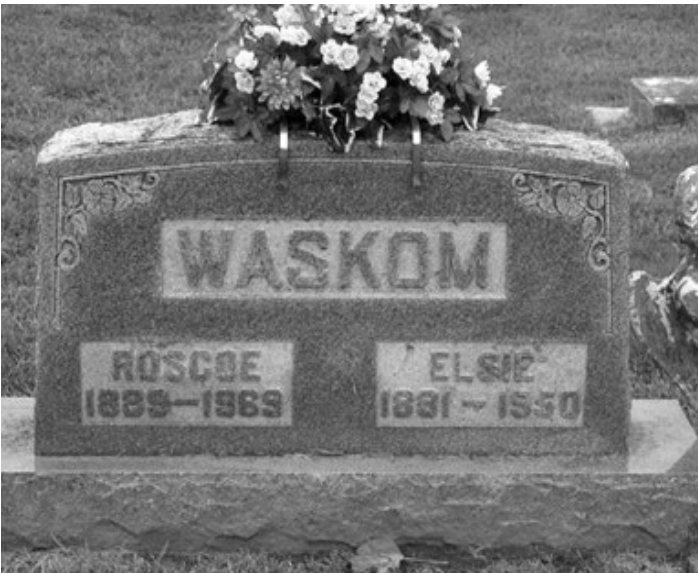

Mrs. Elsie Waskom Dies in Kentucky

Mrs. Elsie Tuell Waskom, 59, of Brownstown, died early Friday afternoon in the Methodist Hospital at Henderson, Ky.

Her unexpected death resulted from a blood clot and a heart condition following an automobile accident near Henderson May 10. Mrs. Waskom's injuries from the accident were not thought to be critical.

She was a life-time resident of Jackson county and was an active member of the Brownstown Baptist church. Her death was a shock to her many friends and relatives in this area.

Mrs. Waskom was born in Valonia April 27, 1891, a daughter of the late Jesse and Emmerette Brown Tuell. She married Roscoe Waskom, who survives, at Brownstown August 17, 1910.

Other survivors include a son, Harry Waskom, of Brownstown; two daughters, Mrs. Clayton Fisher, of Seymour, and Mrs. Walter Guernsey, of Paducah, Ky.; three sisters, Miss Ruth Tuell and Mrs. Mella Robbins, both of Indianapolis, and Mrs. Georgia Reinbold, of Brownstown, and five grandchildren. One son died in infancy.

Mrs. Tuell was returning from a visit at the home of Mrs. Guernsey at Paducah when she was injured in the accident.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Monday afternoon from the Brownstown Baptist Church with the Rev. Walter Moseley, Baptist pastor of Uniontown, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery at Brownstown.
