Waskom—John Lexas Waskom, age 75, passed away at his home south of Brownstown on the Brownstown-Vallonia road Wednesday night, April 17. He had been ill with a complication of diseases for a year but had been confined to his bed for only a week.

Mr. Waskom was a life-long resident of Jackson county. He was the son of Joseph and Martha Kelly Waskom and was born in Grassy Fork township July 31, 1859. He was married to Miss Dora Fislar about nineteen years ago. He was a member of the Masonic lodge and the Vallonia Christian church. He was a farmer by occupation and was a highly respected citizen.
