Roscoe Waskom, Lifelong County Resident, Dies

Roscoe H. Waskom, 80, 115 Vallonia Road, Brownstown, died Wednesday at Methodist Evangelical Hospital, Louisville, Ky., after an illness of two years.

A charter member, he was one of the oldest members of the Brownstown Baptist Church and had been a lifelong resident of that community.

He retired 10 years ago after working for the Kieffer Paper Mills for 50 years.

Born Oct. 3, 1889, in Brownstown, he was the son of the late Omri and Emma Pfening Waskom. In 1910 in Brownstown he married the former Elsie Tuell, who died in 1950.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Clayton C. (Mildred) Fisher, of Seymour and Mrs. Walter J. (Lois) Guernsey, of Lexington, Ky.; five grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.
