Ruth Jane Waskom, 88, Brownstown, died at 11:16 a.m. Thursday, June 22, 2006, at Hoosier Christian Village, Brownstown.

Mrs. Waskom was a member of Brownstown Christian Church. She was a homemaker and candy maker. She was a member of Brownstown Chapter 264, Order of Eastern Star, for 50-plus years, and was very active in the Women's Circle at Brownstown Christian Church, was a former Sunday school teacher and was very active in Hoosier Christian Village Auxiliary.
