Mrs. Bertie Weaver, 74, Dies—Services Monday

Mrs. Bertie Weaver, 74, who resided on a Freetown rural route just west of Brownstown, died at 8:45 o'clock Friday night at the residence. She had been in failing health for several years and bed-fast since January.
