Leukemia Fatal To 9-Year-Old Son Of Mr., Mrs. Arthur Weddell

Ill for several years with incurable leukemia, Michael Byron Weddell, nine-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Weddell, formerly of Brownstown and Medora, died suddenly at 10:30 o'clock this morning at the home of an uncle, Kermit Weddell, and Mrs. Weddell, at Sunman.

The little boy was on his father's lap watching television and had been joking with his father minutes before his death.

Michael Byron was born November 9, 1956 at Medora.

He is a grandson of Mrs. Hazel Weddell, and a nephew of Mrs. Thomas Kieffer, and Mrs. David Branaman, of Brownstown.

The family returned only recently from Tehran, Iran, where Mr. Weddell was superintendent of the American School. On January 25 he is to assume the superintendency of the Delphi Community School Corporation.

The little boy's maternal grandparents are Mr. and Mrs. M. J. Kennedy, of Jacksonville, North Carolina.

Funeral rites will be held at 1:30 o'clock Thursday afternoon from the Cooks Mortuary, in Sunman. The funeral party will leave immediately for Brownstown where burial will be in Fairview Cemetery, here.

Also surviving with the parents are a 15-year-old brother, James Arthur, and a young sister, Mia Suzanne Weddell.
