DIED—Eli D. Applegate, Monday, Dec. 1, 1890, at his home in Ludlow Grove, Hamilton county, Ohio, of heart trouble.

The deceased was born near Charleston, Clarke county, Indiana, in 1824. He was married at the age of 26 to Miss Adaline Richards, who died on April 12, 1854, leaving him two sons, Leander and Leroy. The next year his babe was taken away, leaving him only Leroy, who still lives and resides at Warrington, Indiana. Mr. Applegate was afterward married to Miss Seria Craycraft. To them was born 5 children—one son, Elmer, who was well known by all who ever seen him as a good boy. He died at Ewing, April 27, 1885, of consumption, and 4 daughters. The oldest died shortly after her marriage to Walter Banks, of the same dread disease. The other three are still living, Mrs. Anna Banks residing at Clinton, Ills., Mrs. Lilla Doerr at Ludlow Grove, and Miss Eva Applegate at the same place. Miss Eva has kept house for her father since their removal from Ewing, which occurred shortly after the death of the loving mother and faithful wife. Owing to sickness, neither Mrs. Doerr nor Mrs. Banks were permitted to attend the burying.

The remains arrived at Ewing on Thursday, Dec. 4, accompanied by his daughter Eva and Mr. Doerr, where they were met by his son Leroy and friends. The remains were then conveyed to the new cemetery and deposited in their final resting place.

Although 66 years of age, Mr. Applegate was enjoying good health, and his death was a great shock to his numerous friends. He leaves three brothers, one sister and four children with a score of friends to mourn his death.
