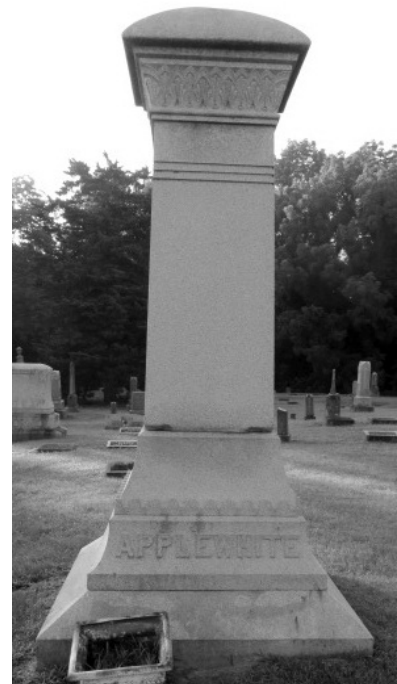

Former Local Woman Dies At Indianapolis

Mrs. Cynthia Applewhite Expires At 84--Mrs. Alex Greger Dies At 85--Other Deaths.

Mrs. Cynthia Anna Applewhite, age 84, widow of James F. Applewhite, passed away at the Methodist hospital in Indianapolis Thursday morning. She had been in failing health for several years but her condition did not become serious until about a week before her death, when a heart ailment developed which was the immediate cause of her death.

Mrs. Applewhite was a former well-known and prominent resident of Brownstown and leaves a host of friends here to mourn her death.

She was born at Jeffersonville, Ind., April 7, 1854, the daughter of Asa B. and Cynthia Ann Jones Carter. Her mother died when she was an infant and she was taken to Seymour where she was reared by her grandmother, Mrs. Gincy Sneed. On May 13, 1873, she was married in Seymour to James F. Applewhite and they came to Brownstown, where they made their home for many years. Mr. Applewhite died December 10, 1906. Mrs. Applewhite moved to Indianapolis.

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
