Mrs. Mattie Barkman, Brownstown Native, Dies—Rites Monday

Funeral services were held Monday afternoon from the Rock of Light Tabernacle here, in charge of the pastor, the Rev. Raymond Gaiter, for Mrs. Mattie Barkman, Brownstown native, and former resident, who died Friday morning at her home in Seymour.

Mrs. Barkman, who had been ill for the past six months, had been a resident of Brownstown until late last summer when she and Mr. Barkman moved to Seymour.

A daughter of the late Thomas Harrison and Julia Coons Smith, the deceased was born January 26, 1884, and would have been seventy years old Tuesday.

In 1898 she was married to Isom Kinworthy and after his death she married Charles F. Barkman, who survives.
